Abnormal Psychology and Physiological Psychology Adjunct Professor Positions Psychology Department

The Psychology Department at St. Mary's University invites applications for adjunct faculty positions for the Fall and Spring semesters, starting Fall 2021, to teach Abnormal Psychology or Physiological Psychology. Candidates for the Abnormal Psychology position must have a PhD in Psychology, preferable in clinical psychology, counseling psychology, or related psychological discipline. Candidates for the Physiological Psychology position must have a PhD in Psychology, preferable in physiological psychology, biological psychology, cognitive/behavioral neuroscience, or related psychological discipline. ABD candidates will be considered for both positions. Experience of at least two years of demonstrated excellence in teaching at the university level is strongly preferred. Teaching responsibilities in the Fall and Spring semesters for each respective adjunct faculty position will include one section of Abnormal Psychology per semester and one section of Physiological Psychology per semester. Candidates will be responsible for administering and grading exams and other course related assignments, and for holding office hours.
